No formal newsletter from me today. Instead, I have written directly to our Team 6 families and children - via Dojo and via Parent Mail.

N.B. ONLY the children of critical workers/ vulnerable children have a place in School from Monday. These priority children are from all year groups: from Reception to Team 6. All these named families have been in direct contact with School. No one should be arriving at School on Monday if they have not been in contact with Mrs Kearney. If anyone does arrive at School (who is not on our risk assessment) they will be asked to go home.

Our Back to School Plan has been a mammoth undertaking and I thank my staff team (governors too) for ensuring everything is in place- as per our extensive risk assessment.

As per the government's guidance, we are NOT opening School to wider year groups and, as I have stated previously, we are unable to prioritise the return of Team 1 & Team Reception before the end of the School year.
