Beheaded	To cut off the head of someone
Guillotine	A machine with a sharp, heavy blade used for beheading someone

Henry VIII	Born 1491 - Died 1547 King of England 1509 – 1547 Second Tudor monarch Established the Church of England
Elizabeth I	Henry VIII's second child Born 1533 - Died 1603 Queen of England 1558 - 1603
Catherine of Aragon	First wife of Henry VIII 1509 – 1533
Anne Boleyn	Second wife of Henry VIII 1533 – 1536 Mother to Queen Elizabeth I
Jane Seymour	Third wife of Henry VIII 1536 - 1537
Anne of Cleves	Fourth wife of Henry VIII 1540 (Jan – July)
Catherine Howard	Fifth wife of Henry VIII 1540 – 1542
Catherine Parr	Sixth wife of Henry VIII 1543 - 1547
Henry VII	Father to Henry VIII and first Tudor monarch
Edward VI	Henry VIII's third child King of England 1547 – 1553 Came onto the throne at the age of 9 Died aged 15
Mary I	Henry VIII's first child Queen of England 1553 - 1558


