<p>Layer different media, e.g. crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal and ballpoint.</p> <p>Draw for a sustained period of time from the figure and real objects, including single and grouped objects.</p> <p>Experiment with the visual elements; line, shape, pattern and colour.</p> <p>Use view finders to focus on specifics.</p>	<p>Mix a range of secondary colours, shades and tones.</p> <p>Experiment with tools and techniques, including layering, mixing media, scraping through etc.</p> <p>Name different types of paint and their properties.</p> <p>Work on a range of scales e.g. large brush on large paper etc.</p> <p>Mix and match colours using artefacts and objects.</p>	<p>Manipulate clay for a variety of purposes, including thumb pots, simple coil pots and models.</p> <p>Build a textured relief tile.</p>	<p>Use a variety of techniques, including mono-print, relief, screen and fabric printing</p> <p>Design patterns of increasing complexity and repetition.</p> <p>Print using a variety of materials, objects and techniques.</p>	<p>Use a variety of techniques, inc. weaving, French knitting, tie-dyeing, fabric crayons and wax or oil resist, appliqué and embroidery.</p> <p>Create textured collages from a variety of media.</p> <p>Stitch, knot and use other manipulative skills.</p> <p>Experiment with cutting, tearing and scrunching.</p>
