## Selected Vocabulary and Definitions

<b>Continent</b>	A large solid area of land made up of countries
<b>Equator</b>	The equator is an imaginary line which goes around the middle of the Earth.
<b>Arctic</b>	The areas at the north of the earth – North Pole.
<b>Antarctica</b>	The area at the south of the earth – South Pole.
<b>Country</b>	An area of land with a defined edge.
<b>Sea</b>	A sea is smaller than an ocean and usually located where the land and an ocean meets.
