<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>Texts – Stone Age Boy The First Drawing How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth</p> <p>Reading books that link with our History topic – The Stone Age Writing Diary Entries Describing characters Reading and writing instructions Different sentence types</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Number - Read and write numbers to at least 1000 in numerals and in words. Place value - Recognise the place value of each digit in a three digit number (hundreds, tens, ones) Addition and subtraction – Add and Subtract numbers mentally, including a three-digit number and ones, tens or hundreds. Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Rocks</u></b> Compare and group together different kinds of rocks based on their appearance and simple physical properties. Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Computing</u></b></p> <p>Use a search engine to find web pages. Understand that not all websites are as reliable as others.</p> <p>Make choices on which program is best for a given task. (Office – Use different programs for a purpose, which is better? E.g. Word Vs Publisher)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>History</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Use an increasing range of common words and phrases relating to the passing of time.</u></b> Early man and survival in Stone Age The importance of Skara Brae Copper mining in the Bronze Age What Stonehenge can teach us about the past Iron Age hillforts.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Art</u></b></p> <p><b><u>To create printing blocks using relief or impressed techniques.</u></b> Print using a variety of materials, objects and techniques including layering. Talk about the processes used to produce a simple print. Explore pattern and shape, creating designs for printing. Relief printing using card and polystyrene</p>
